

## Sponsorship Opportunities

## 2) Sponsor a Program-

<u>Free Family Saturdays</u>- \$100 per day provides an artist instructor, a student teacher, and all the supplies for an open house art making experience. Second Saturdays from 2-4pm all are welcome to try their hand at making. Jewelry, drawing, painting, print and bookmaking, sculpture, sewing, and more introduce community residents to the benefits of arts participation. Available in 3, 6, or 12 month increments.

<u>Swirladelic</u>- Offer an amazing silk printing experience for employees, friends, or the community of the Baltimore County Arts Guild. Design and print a one of a kind silk scarf. This method is fascinating, and fun for all ages. It creates a masterpiece every time. Priced at \$40 per person for a scarf, glass of wine or juice, and light fare. (Additional scarves may be made and purchased at event \$35 each.) 25 person minimum or \$1000.



<u>Celebrate Youth Art Month</u>- In March we exhibit works from Baltimore County High School students and offer cash and prize awards totaling \$700. Public, Private, Home Schooled, and students with special needs all participate, and the work is superb. For \$800 Sponsors can also provide refreshments for the award evening.
